Introduction

What a mind-blowing year of growth for Sam Weeks Consulting.

We took on 60 clients, our highest intake ever. To accommodate this extra demand, we grew our MBA admissions consulting team by recruiting HBS graduate, Zack Hoyt.

Of our 60 clients, an incredible 92% secured admits, sharing \$2,398,000 in scholarship offers. The highlight was our unprecedented HSW success rate of 46%.

Reflecting this success, we were featured in the Poets&Quants top small-sized MBA admissions consultancies list, and Sam was among the top individual consultants of 2024.

Broadening our offering, we added 6 schools to our self-guided course, MBAconsultant.com, which now contains over 100 example essays.

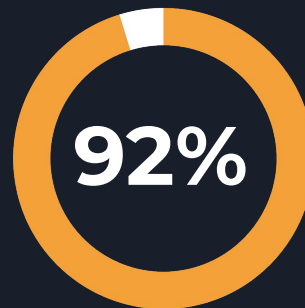
Our Results

In 2023-24, The team at Sam Weeks Consulting worked with 60 MBA applicants. Of these, 55 secured admits to 1 or more of their target schools. That's a **client success rate of 92%**.

34 clients applied to M7 schools and 22 were successful. That's an **M7 success rate of 65%**.

Out of 180 school applications, 99 were successful. That's a **school success rate of 55%**.

Scholarships

Overall, **31%** of admitted clients received scholarship offers, sharing **\$2,398,000** of scholarships between them (averaging **\$43,600** each).

This year, our clients received 5 full-ride scholarships for their MBAs.

M7

US schools were 76% of applications, higher than in previous years.

Clients received admits from all the M7 schools: **Harvard Business School, Stanford GSB, Wharton, MIT Sloan, Chicago Booth, Kellogg and Columbia.**

34 clients applied to M7 schools. Of these, 22 were admitted to one or more M7. That's an **M7 success rate of 65%.**

We had a particularly strong year for Harvard, Stanford and Wharton applications.

In total, 26 clients applied to Harvard, Stanford or Wharton, and 12 received offers from one or more of these schools. That's a **HSW success rate of 46%**.

Incredibly, one client received offers from all three of these top schools.

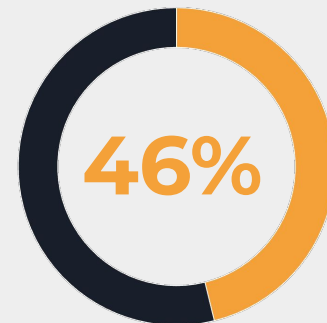
Another heroic client received an offer from HBS with a GRE score of only 320.

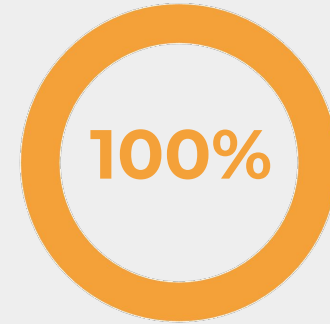
International Programs

We've always had a strong presence in Europe, but this year's results were astonishing.

In total, 19 clients applied to INSEAD, LBS, Oxford or Cambridge. All of them received an admit to one or more program. That's a **International program success rate of 100%**.

Incredibly, 8 clients applied to INSEAD and all 8 were admitted. That's an **INSEAD success rate of 100%**.

That will be a tough record to beat.

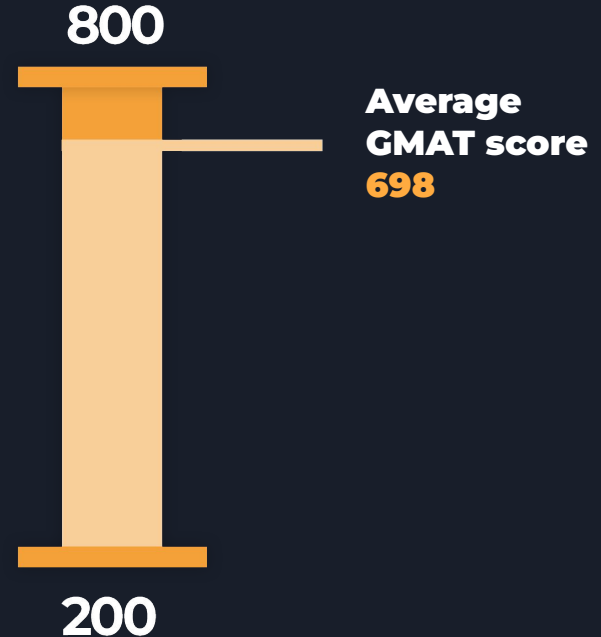


By GMAT & GPA

The average GMAT score (or GRE equivalent) of our clients fell to **698**. Perhaps score inflation is abating.

The lowest GMAT score of any successful applicant was 460.

The average GPA of our clients was **3.50/4.00**. One client secured multiple admits and scholarships with a GPA of 2.40/4.00.

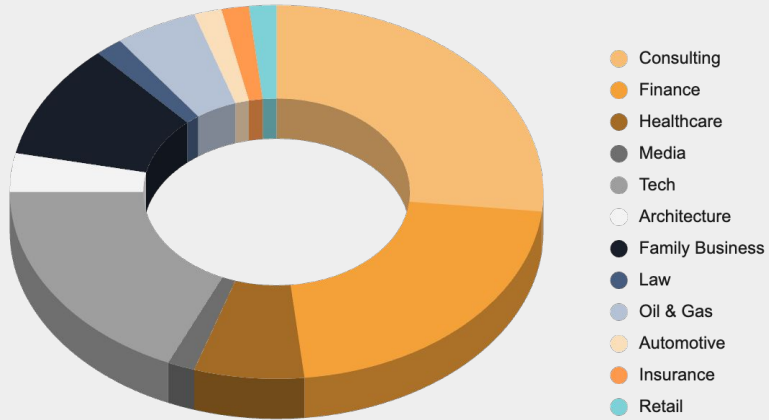

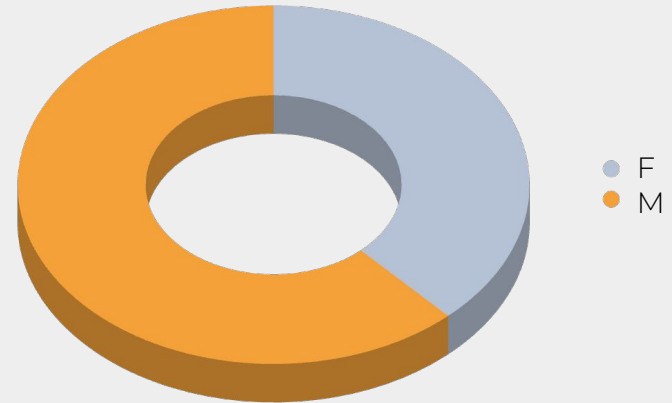
Industry

The Male:Female ratio of our clients was **60:40**



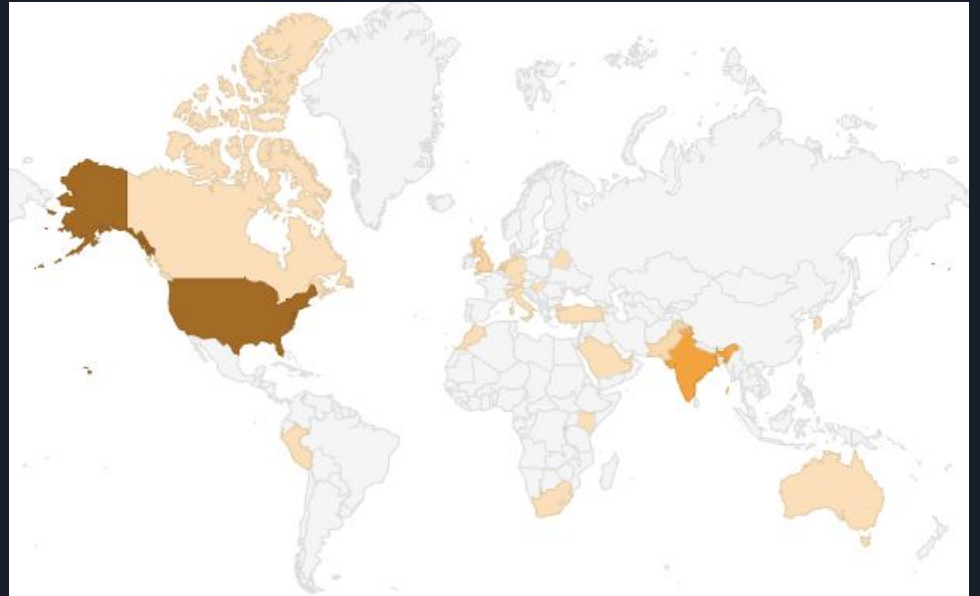

We recruited one new admissions consultant:

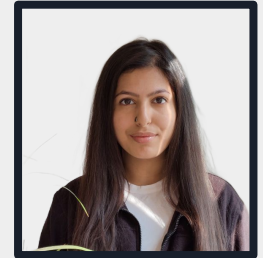
Zack Hoyt is a graduate of Harvard Business School. With experience in the US navy and MBB consulting, Zack brings a valuable perspective to the firm.

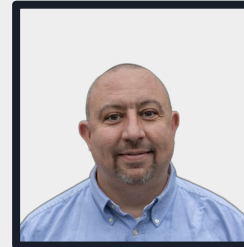

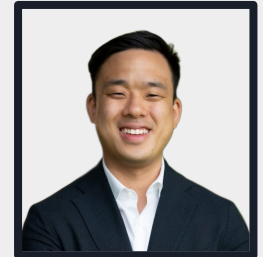

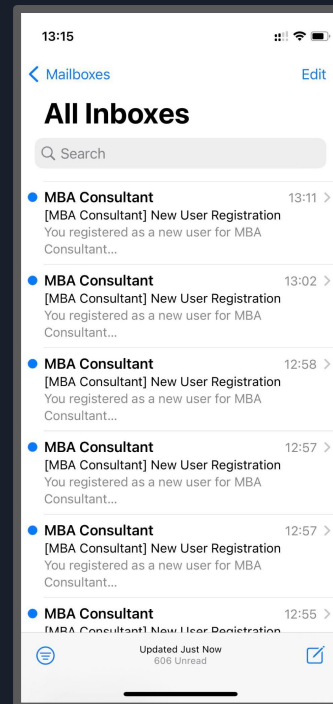


MBAconsultant.com

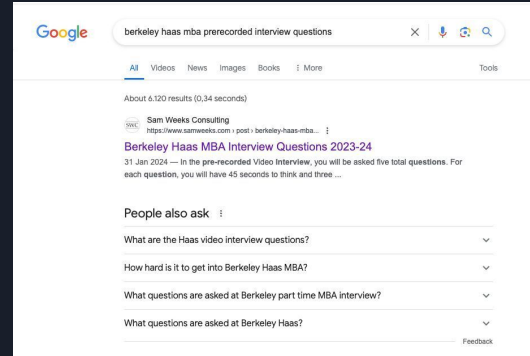

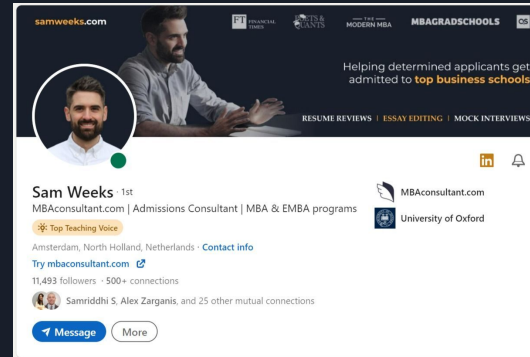
